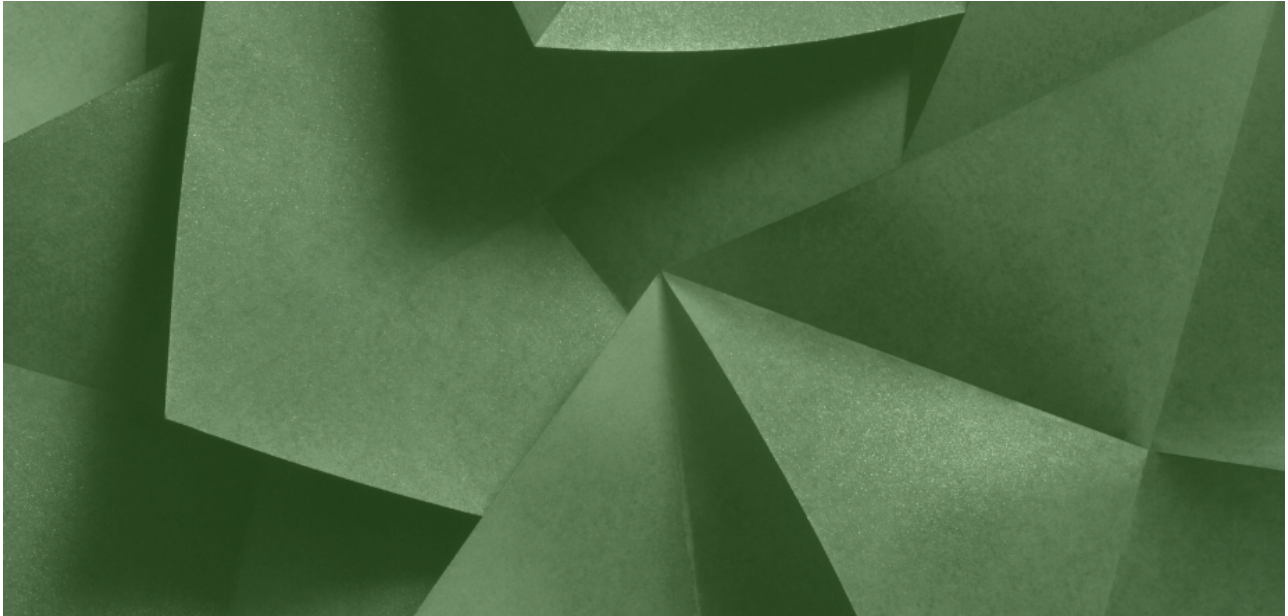


An Update from Lowndes CEO & President: Sheltering in Place
